Free to good homes I have a number of books in the 'Bible for Everyone' series written by Tom Wright (former Bishop of Durham and currently Senior Research Fellow at Wycliffe Hall in the University of Oxford). They are all in excellent condition and are suitable for anyone who wishes to read one of the New Testament books with a non-academic commentary or guide. The style of these books make them particularly useful if engaging in a daily bible reading since each short passage of scripture is followed by Tom Wright's reflection. The books are available at the back of church and, as the heading suggests **free to good homes** – although **if you would like to make a small donation to St Mary's no one will stop you!** The titles available are: Matthew (2 vols); Mark; Luke; John(2 vols); Romans (2 vols); 1 Corinthians; 2 Corinthians; Galatians and Thessalonians; The Prison Letters (1 vol covering Ephesians, Philippians, Colossians and Philemon); The Pastoral Letters (1 vol covering 1 and 2 Timothy and Titus); Hebrews; Revelation. There is also a 'For Everyone' Bible Study Guide on Revelation which could be used by an individual or in a group discussion. Jean Hockett.
